CM Waldo made a motion, seconded by CM Conway, to adopt the Consent Calendar items A, B, & C as proposed. The motion was carried unanimously by all present.

D. Adopt Resolution No. 2011-17 authorizing the continued participation in the City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County (C/CAG) and authorizing the Mayor to execute the Joint Powers Agreement

CM Conway acknowledged that former Mayor and Councilmember Ray Miller was involved in the formation of C/CAG in the 1990's. CM Conway made a motion, seconded by CM Waldo, adopting the resolution as proposed. The motion was carried unanimously by all present.
