## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Accept the \$50,810 Brisbane Share of the Regional Grant of \$508,082 for upgrade of selfcontained breathing apparatus, replacement of structural firefighting turnouts, thermal imaging cameras and gas monitors.

# **BACKGROUND:**

North County Fire Authority, utilizing the City of Daly, applied for grant funding in September 2011 and was awarded the grant funds to upgrade self-contained breathing apparatus, replace structural firefighting turnouts, thermal imaging cameras and gas monitors for all the of North County Fire Authority (Brisbane, Daly City, and Pacifica).

### **DISCUSSION:**

Through the \$508,082 FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant Funding, 80% or \$406,466 of the total costs will covered with the total local match being \$101,616 or 20% of the total grant. The grant match portion of the funding will be split proportionately with the local shares being Brisbane \$10,162, Daly City \$66,050 and Pacifica \$25,404 and Daly City will be the lead agency on this grant.

## FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING ISSUES

City of Brisbane will contribute \$10,162 in matching funds and will receive \$50,810 in needed equipment.
