for the purchase of a Fire Ground Survival Training Mobile Trailer and

Instructor Training

RECOMMENDATION:

Accept the \$568.90 Brisbane Share of the Regional FEMA Firefighter Assistance Grant Award of \$56,890.00 for the purchase of Fire Ground Survival Training Mobile Trailer and Instructor Training within North County Fire Authority.

BACKGROUND:

North County Fire Authority, utilizing the City of Daly City, applied for a Regional FEMA Firefighter Assistance Grant and was awarded funds to purchase a Fire Ground Survival Training Mobile Trailer and Instructor Training for all the of North County Fire Authority (Brisbane, Daly City, and Pacifica).

DISCUSSION:

Through the \$56,890.00 FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant Funding, 90% or \$51,201.00 of the total costs will be covered with the local match being \$5,689.00 or 10%. The grant match portion of the funding will be split proportionately with the local shares being Brisbane \$568.90. Daly City \$3,726.30 and Pacifica \$1,393.80.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING ISSUES

City of Brisbane will contribute \$568.90 in matching funds and will receive a \$56,890.00 value in equipment and training. Funds are budgeted from 100-52243-3001 in the amount of \$568.90.
