# Background:

June 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014 – Staff presented an overview of the budget to the City Council and City Clerk Budget

June 9<sup>th</sup> 2014 – City Council reviewed the Fire, City Council, City Manager, City Clerk, Library, Co-Sponsored Events, Administrative Services, Open Space and Ecology Human Resources, City-wide, and Parks and Recreation budgets

June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014 – City Council reviewed the Police, Public works, Marina, Capital Improvement Projects, and Community Development.

# Discussion

Changes to the Budget

Attachment A of the Resolution lists the items which were specifically discussed by City Council and the resulting changes in the budget.

#### Fiscal Impact:

Based on the changes the City Council has made the projected deficit for FY 2014/15 is approximately \$719,000. There are enough General Fund reserves to provide for this deficit. It is anticipated the General Reserves will be approximately \$9,900,000 as of June 30, 2015. This amount includes the amount which was previously set aside in the Rainy Day Fund.
