Boardmember Blackwood made a motion, seconded by Boardmember Porter to adopt the resolution and budget as proposed. The motion passed unanimously by all present.

b. Consider adoption of Resolution No. OB 2013-04 approving the issuance and sale of tax allocation refunding bonds of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Brisbane to refinance Redevelopment and Low and Moderate Income Housing activities within and for the benefit of the projects of the former Redevelopment Agency of the City of Brisbane

Administrative Services Director Schillinger and Special Bond Counsel Brian Quint reviewed the proposed refunding of the bonds, explaining the background and the savings that the refinance would produce. They also explained that the Department of Finance would have 60-days to review the bond issue after the Oversight Boards approval.

After Boardmember questions and clarifications, Boardmember Blackwood made a motion, seconded by Boardmember Porter, to adopt the minutes as proposed. The motion was carried unanimously by all present.
