### **RESOLUTION NO. 2013-40**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRISBANE ADOPTING COUNTY OF SAN MATEO CERTIFICATION OF VOTES AND DECLARING RESULTS OF MEASURE T, AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 5.20.011 OF THE BRISBANE MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE THE BUSINESS LICENSE TAX CHARGED TO LIQUID STORAGE FACILITIES, AT THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2013

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held in and throughout the City of Brisbane on the fifth day of November, 2013, for the purpose of submitting Measure T, an ordinance adding Section 5.20.011 of the Brisbane Municipal Code to increase the business license tax charged to liquid storage facilities, to the qualified electors; and
