A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRISBANE RECOGNIZING MAY 18-24, 2014 AS PUBLIC WORKS WEEK

WHEREAS, Public Works Week is a national celebration of the tens of thousands of men and women in North America who provide and maintain the infrastructures and services collectively known as "public works"; and

WHEREAS, these critical services are provided daily by professionals who serve the public good with quiet dedication; and
