SUBJECT: Construction Contract for 2013 Slurry Seal Project (No. 9E00)

City Council Goals: To maintain and improve infrastructure. (3)

Purpose: Provide preventative maintenance and repair to various streets in Brisbane.

Recommendation: Award the construction contract for the 2013 Slurry Seal Project to VSS International, Inc. in the amount of \$ 145,300.00, and authorize the Mayor to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City.

Background:

The City received the following bids on September 26, 2013:

VSS International, Inc.	\$ 145,300.00
Windsor Fuel Co.	\$ 155,635.00
American Asphalt, Inc.	\$ 164,315.00
Bond Blacktop, Inc.	\$ 182,742.00
Graham Contractors, Inc.	\$ 183,960.00
Intermountain Slurry Seal	\$ 190,800.00


Staff reviewed the apparent low bid and determined that the proposal was responsive and the bidder was responsible. The low bid was slightly above the engineer's estimate of \$ 140,000, but below the budgeted amount for construction.

Fiscal Impact:

One hundred percent of funds needed are available for this project in FY13-14 CIP Fund 9E00.
