


### **Background:**

On June 16, 2009, the City Council called an election to submit to the voters a proposed ordinance to increase the rate of the uniform transient occupancy tax from ten percent (10%) to twelve percent (12%).

### **Discussion:**

The attached Resolution declares the results of the election that was held on November 3, 2009. The measure passed by the majority needed. Specifically, there were a total of 536 votes in favor of the special tax, and 292 votes against.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRISBANE  
ADOPTING COUNTY OF SAN MATEO CERTIFICATION OF VOTES  
AND DECLARING RESULTS OF MEASURE G, AN INCREASE IN THE TRANSIENT  
OCCUPANCY TAX FOR HOTELS, AT THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2009**

**WHEREAS**, a General Municipal Election was held in and throughout the City of Brisbane on the third day of November, 2009, for the purpose of submitting Measure G, an increase in the Transient Occupancy Tax for Hotels, to the qualified electors; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Clerk of said City has duly posted and presented to the City Council of the City of Brisbane the County of San Mateo's certification of the votes cast in Consolidated Precincts 1, 2 and 3, for this Measure in said General Municipal Election; and

**WHEREAS**, said City Council has access to and has examined said certification of votes cast in Consolidated Precincts 1, 2, and 3.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Brisbane finds as follows:

1. The number of votes cast at Consolidated Precinct No. 1 was 355; the number of votes cast at Consolidated Precinct No. 2 was 343; the number of votes cast at Consolidated Precinct No. 3 was 170; to make the total number of votes cast in said election to be 868.
2. That the record of votes cast in said election including absent voter ballots, is shown on Exhibit "A" of the Certificate of the Chief Elections Official, attached hereto, and by such reference made a part hereof.
3. That Measure G, an increase in the Transient Occupancy Tax for Hotels, passed by the majority needed.


