Dear Councilmembers:

Please stand by the Planning Commission's recent findings. Do not let yourselves be bullied by UPC or outsiders.

The Planning Commission's concerns with respect to toxicity, sea-rise and infrastructure support are valid, and the Commissioners ought to be recognized for their diligence and hard work.

At one of the first UPC-Council presentations, UPC told us they could not build housing due to the toxicity of the site. Now they are asking us to build a new city and call it Brisbane. This could easily become a case of the tail wagging the dog, with the current residents of Brisbane being stuck with the vet bill when the developer is no longer around to complete or support the massive new infrastructure that will be required.
