Baylands, East of Bayshore Boulevard, between Icehouse Hill and the

CalTrain rail lines (Assessor's Parcel Numbers 005-162-320 & 330)

ZONING:

C-1 Commercial Mixed Use District (Baylands)

REQUEST:

Interim Use Permit to allow the previously approved interim use to continue through December 2020, to allow for outdoor staging of construction materials and equipment and assembly of work trains and rail track segments on an approximately 3.5 acre vacant site with an existing rail spur, in support of

improvements along the CalTrain rail-line corridor.

ENVIRONMENTAL

STATUS:

This project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Sections 15304(e) of the CEQA Guidelines. The exceptions to these categorical exemptions, referenced in Section 15300.2, do not apply.
