Subject: Construction Contract for Tunnel Avenue Rehabilitation Project (No. 9H02)

Community Goal/Result

Safe Community

Purpose

Provide maintenance and repair to the city-owned portion of Tunnel Ave. in Brisbane, and improve stormwater surface drainage.

Recommendation

Award the construction contract for the Tunnel Avenue Rehabilitation Project, on the city-owned portion of Tunnel Avenue (northern city limit to the southern end of the City-owned roadway approximately 1700' south of Beatty Avenue), to G. Bortolotto & Company, Inc. in the amount of \$ 387,227.35, and authorize the Mayor to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City.

Background

The City received the following bids on April 18, 2019:

G. Bortolotto & Co., Inc.	\$ 387,227.35
Interstate Grading and Paving, Inc.	\$ 396,030.50
O'Grady Paving, Inc.	\$ 508,985.00
HM Construction, Inc.	\$ 513,978.00

Staff reviewed the apparent low bid and determined that the proposal was responsive and the bidder was responsible. The low bid was below the engineer's estimate of \$ 400,000. The contractor anticipates completing this work in the summer.

Fiscal Impact


One hundred percent of funds needed are available for this project in FY18-19 CIP Fund 9H02.
