Subject: Fire Main Replacement Project - Phase 2 (Project No. 9F08)

Community Goal/Result: Safe Community

Purpose: To provide fire flow capacity per the 2016 California Fire Code (CFC) criteria within the benefitting neighborhoods; this action is consistent with the community's value of public safety.

Recommendation: Award the construction contract for the Fire Main Replacement Project – Phase 2 (Project No. 9F08), to JMB Construction in the amount of \$2,062,635, and authorize the Mayor to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City.

Background: The City received the following bids on July 8, 2019:

Engineer's Estimate	\$3,855,000
Westland Contractors	\$3,243,025
Cratus, Inc.	\$3,647,150
JMB Construction	\$2,062,635

Staff reviewed the apparent low bid and determined that the proposal was responsive and the bidder was responsible.

Fiscal Impact

On April 16, 2015, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2015-11 authorizing the issuance and sale of \$5M of revenue bonds to finance improvements to the city's public utilities. A portion of the Utility Bond Measure will cover the construction of this project.
