Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the City of Brisbane Planning Commission on **Thursday, September 22, 2016, at 7:30 p.m., Brisbane City Hall, 50 Park Place, Brisbane**, to consider the following matter:

APPLICATION NO.: **Zoning Text Amendment RZ-4-16**

APPLICANT: **City of Brisbane**

LOCATION: **Various Citywide**

ZONING: **Various Citywide**

REQUEST: **Zoning Text Amendments to Title 16, Subdivisions, and Title 17, Zoning, of the Brisbane Municipal Code (BMC) to update existing subdivision and public noticing regulations to be consistent with current California Government Code and Civil Code requirements, and to amend the discretionary review process for newly constructed condominium developments.**

ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS: **Categorical Exemption per State CEQA Guidelines Section 15183(a)- this project falls within a class of projects which are consistent with existing zoning or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall therefore not require further review. The exceptions to this categorical exemption referenced in Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines do not apply.**

If you challenge the application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Any attendee who wishes accommodation for a disability should contact the Community Development Department at least forty-eight hours prior to the meeting.
