Fall is upon us!

Fall is officially here and the weather is nothing short of spectacular! So if you have been wanting to get out on the water, now is the time!

Unfortunately, this lovely weather won't last forever. That said, you need to ask yourself, "Have I gone to the boat lately and checked on it?" Winter weather can be extremely harsh with high winds, above average rainfall and downright cold temperatures. That means you need to plan ahead and make sure your vessel's bilge pumps are in good working order, drains/scuppers are clear and dock lines are in good, secure condition! Also as good practice, close any thru-hulls below waterline that are not necessary to be open, because no-one needs that "sinking" feeling!

A friendly reminder—nothing is to be stored on the docks or fingers at any time. Please stow any belongings, tools, saw horses, etc. inside your boat or in the provided dock box adjacent to your slip.

October is a *great* month! Along with the colors beginning to change, you can find

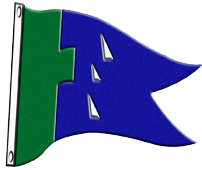
