REQUEST:

Text Amendments to Title 17, Zoning, of the Brisbane Municipal Code (BMC) to implement Housing Element Program H.B.1.f amending the definition of "Single-family dwelling," modify existing regulations to achieve internal consistency within the Municipal Code, and to amend the appeals process for Planning Commission decisions. Chapters to be amended include Chapter 17.02, Definitions, Chapter 17.32, General Use Regulations, and Chapter 17.52, Appeals. No changes to zoning district classifications or to the boundaries of any zoning district for any property

are proposed.

ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS:

Project Consistent with the General Plan per State CEQA Guidelines Section 15183(a)--this proposal falls within a class of projects which are consistent with existing zoning or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall therefore not require further review. The exception to this section requiring environmental review as might be necessary to

examine project specific significant effects does not apply.

If you challenge the application in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Any attendee who wishes accommodation for a disability should contact the Community Development Department at least forty-eight hours prior to the meeting.
