City Manager Holstine reported that the Council will decide on who should represent the City and Guadalupe Valley Municipal Improvement District (GVMID) on both Bay Area Water Supply Conservation Agency (BAWSCA) and Bay Area Regional Water System Financing Authority (RFA) at the next City Council Meeting of June 6, 2019. Currently Public Works Director Breault is the GVMID representative and former Mayor and Councilmember Sepi Richardson is the City representative. The BAWSCA City Representative cannot be a Councilmember at this time because the BAWSCA board meeting time conflicts with City Council meeting times.
