Brisbane Municipal Code concerning operating requirements of massage

establishments.

DATE: September 1, 2016

City Council Goals:

To provide public service that assures the safety of property and citizens residing, working or visiting in Brisbane. (Goal #9)

Recommendation:

That the City Council adopt Ordinance No. 608.

Background:

On July 14, 2016 the City Council considered revisions to the City's regulations regarding massage establishments. The proposed revisions included zoning ordinance changes to regulate massage establishments differently from other personal services, and changes to the massage operating requirements (BMC Section 8) to post signs concerning human trafficking as required per the California Civil Code.

By a vote of 5-0 the City Council introduced Ordinance 608 in part by approving the additional sign posting requirements in Section 8, and denying the Planning commission-recommended revisions to the zoning ordinance. As a result, massage establishments will continue to be regulated under the zoning ordinance like all other personal services. The attached ordinance reflects the City Council's action on this matter.
