**SUBJECT:** **Adoption of Ordinance No. 608**, Text Amendment to Section 8.10.100 of the Brisbane Municipal Code concerning operating requirements of massage establishments.

**DATE:** September 1, 2016

**City Council Goals:**

To provide public service that assures the safety of property and citizens residing, working or visiting in Brisbane. (Goal #9)

**Recommendation:**

That the City Council adopt Ordinance No. 608.

**Background:**

On July 14, 2016 the City Council considered revisions to the City's regulations regarding massage establishments. The proposed revisions included zoning ordinance changes to regulate massage establishments differently from other personal services, and changes to the massage operating requirements (BMC Section 8) to post signs concerning human trafficking as required per the California Civil Code.

By a vote of 5-0 the City Council introduced Ordinance 608 in part by approving the additional sign posting requirements in Section 8, and denying the Planning commission-recommended revisions to the zoning ordinance. As a result, massage establishments will continue to be regulated under the zoning ordinance like all other personal services. The attached ordinance reflects the City Council's action on this matter.

**ORDINANCE NO. 608**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8.10.100 OF THE  
MUNICIPAL CODE REQUIRING THAT NOTICES  
CONCERNING HUMAN TRAFFICKING BE POSTED IN  
MESSAGE ESTABLISHMENTS**

**The City Council of the City of Brisbane hereby ordains as follows:**

**SECTION 1:**

Section 8.10.100 (Operating Requirements) of Chapter 8.10 (Message Establishments) is amended to read as follows:

**“Section 8.10.100 Operating requirements.**

Unless otherwise specified herein, all message establishments shall comply with the following operating requirements.

(Subsections A-J, no change.)

K. Each message establishment shall post the notice required to be posted under State Civil Code, section 52.6 (concerning human trafficking and slavery).”
