SUBJECT: 2016 Cold-in-Place Recycling Project (Project No. 9037)

Recommendation:

Approve the plans and specifications, and authorize publication of the Notice Inviting Bids for the 2016 Cold-in-Place Recycling Project (Project No. 9037).

City Council Goals:

To maintain and improve infrastructure. (#3)

Purpose:

Provide maintenance and repair to the southerly section of Bayshore Boulevard in Brisbane, utilizing a more environmentally-friendly method than standard pavement rehabilitation.

Background:

This construction project will cold-in-place recycle and overlay Bayshore Boulevard from approximately 650' south of Old County Road to the southern city limits, utilizing Measure A and Gas Tax funds. Cold-in-place recycling of existing asphalt pavement allows for the immediate reuse of failed asphalt concrete pavement without the expense and environmental impacts of both hauling the material to a recycling facility and bringing back replacement material. Approximately 2,500 cubic yards of asphalt concrete pavement will be recycled in place, in lieu of importing nearly 400 truckloads of asphalt-concrete.

Traffic lanes will be closed during portions of the construction. Working hours will be between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Inconveniences to the motoring public will be managed with a traffic control plan.

For California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) compliance, the project was determined to be Categorically Exempt, and a Notice of Exemption was prepared on August 22, 2016. No further action on this environmental determination is required by Council.

Fiscal Impact:

Funds are programmed as follows for this project: FY 16-17 CIP Fund 9037 \$933,000.

The engineer's estimate for this project is \$826,000, and contingencies are estimated at \$40,000.

Additional unspent sales tax and gas tax funds will be used for future pavement maintenance projects.
